



Olga Budimir was awarded the Fellowship of the IPA in 2006 in recognition of the outstanding contribution she made to both the IPA and the industry.

The citation reads, “Olga has been a long-serving and very active champion of the Creative Services discipline within the IPA. She has served the Creative Services Group for many years, and indeed in the autumn of 2004 she single-handedly resurrected it.

She helped develop a training course for the Creative Services people through Watford College; helped put together (in 2002), and has since chaired, the annual, examined IPA Press and Print Production Knowledge course; and also contributed to discussions with ISBA on gatekeeping in 2003.

Under her Chairmanship, the Creative Services Group has developed a second, manager-level course, which will run for the first time this spring (2006) and will be examined.”
